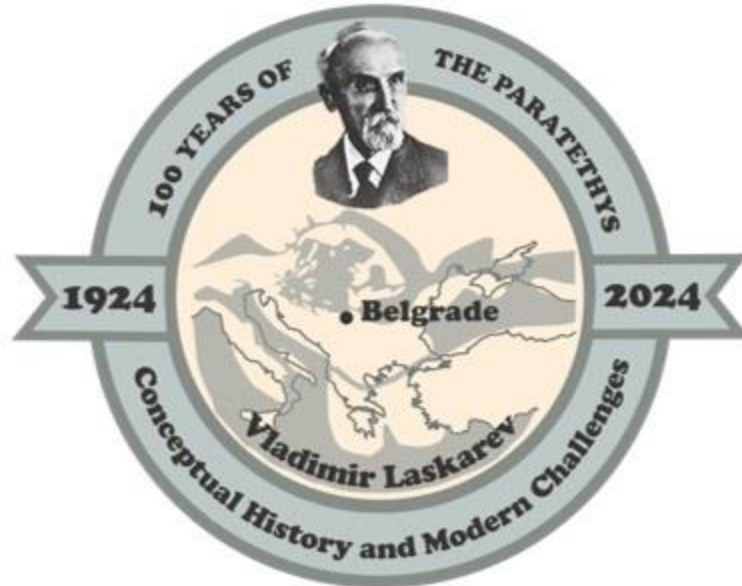

EVENT LANGUAGE

The operational language of the conference will be English.

INSTRUCTION FOR AUTHORS

Oral presentations should be prepared in Microsoft Power Point. Presentation time is limited to 15 minutes (20 min. for the invited lecturers), including 3 minutes for discussion. Posters should be prepared in portrait A0 format. The official time for presentation is about 5 minutes.

MEALS

During the conference, vegetarian meals will be available for the participants.

TIME ZONE

Serbia uses the Central European time zone. Belgrade, as the capital of Serbia, belongs to that time zone. During wintertime, the time zone is GMT +1, and during summertime, GMT +2 shows the zone.

CURRENCY

The official tender in Serbia is dinar, abbreviated RSD. Money may be exchanged in all banks and post offices, as well as in authorized exchange offices. Dinar is issued in denominations of 10/20/50/100/200/500/1000/5000. For one euro can get about 117 dinars. ACCOMMODATION

Belgrade is one of the largest and most important business cities in this part of Europe and the Balkan region. It is highly recommended to book accommodation well in advance. HOW TO REACH BELGRADE

The Nikola Tesla International airport of Belgrade is served by the major airlines connecting many international destinations. The airport is about 13 km from the city center.

ticket from the NT airport costs ca. 4 euro (ca. 500 dinars) and the drive takes about 30 minutes. Taxi services cost ca. 22-30 euros (2.600-3.600 dinars).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The public transportation in Belgrade is affordable and is one of the efficient ways to reach your destination. There are different ticket options including temporarily ticket for 90 minutes ("VREMENSKA KARTA") that costs 50 dinars (less than 0.5 euros), and daily ticket ("DNEVNA KARTA") of 120 dinars (about 1 euro).

Tickets can be purchased by SMS, at kiosks or paid by bank card in the bus. If it is bought from the driver, then it is slightly more expensive. Additional option is to install the official mobile phone app: Beograd Plus, on which you can make an account and pay any ticket.
